## Welcome to a new term at Harewood Nursery School

I'd like to express a warm welcome to all our new children and their families and welcome back to school to those who have been with us a while already.

I am pleased to say that all the children are settling in nicely to their new classes and routines. The staff are working hard to ensure that your children are happy to come to school and are enjoying their time with us.

### Exciting Times . . .

We have lots planned over the coming year and the term including lots of fun activities and lots of learning. We would like you to share your children's adventures too so we have opportunities for children to bring things in from home, opportunities for children to take things home and also our stay and play days for you to come and join in for an hour with the children.

### Help your children to . . .

It would really help us to help your children if you can support their independence with:

- taking off and putting on their shoes and wellies
- taking off and putting on their coats, including turning them the right way round and hanging them on a peg
- going to the toilet, including wiping their own bottoms and washing their hands
- identifying their name in their coats/shoes/ clothes, please ensure that everything has your child's name on
- sit at a table to eat their lunch

We have had a lovely summer but the weather will soon change, please ensure that children are prepared to play outside whatever the weather – we have waterproof all-in-ones but children will need their own wellies, hats and gloves.

The disturbing news over the summer that yet another child has choked on a piece of sausage has prompted me to ask you to NOT include sausages or sausage rolls in lunch boxes. Lunches should be healthy and balanced where possible. A sandwich, fruit and a biscuit is plenty.

Children have a snack mid-morning and again in the afternoon. We do not charge for our daily snacks but we do ask for a voluntary contribution of just **£1 per week** towards the cost, this also goes towards other consumables such as baking ingredients throughout the year.
