Uniform . . .

We have lots planned over the coming year and the term including lots of fun activities and lots of learning. We would like you to share your children's adventures too so we have opportunities for children to bring things in from home, opportunities for children to take things home and also our stay and play days for you to come and join in for an hour with the children; more information to follow.

We will also be doing lots of learning outside in our lovely new nursery garden. Help your children to . . .

It would really help us to help your children if you can support their independence with:

- taking off and putting on their shoes and wellies
- taking off and putting on their coats, including turning them the right way round and hanging them on a peg
- going to the toilet, including wiping their own bottoms and washing their hands
- identifying their name in their coats/shoes/ clothes, please ensure that everything has your child's name on
- sit at a table to eat their lunch
