HOW TO MAKE A BILLY GOAT



Learning Opportunities

The children learning about different ways of creating objects using a variety of materials, constructing with a purpose. They discover how to attach materials together, developing an understanding how to manipulate materials.

They can use them to build on their language and imagination skills, as they retell the story or create new ones.



You will need -

A tube

Paper or paint

Two pegs

Cotton wool

Craft eyes (optical.)

Pens, pencils or crayons

Scissors and glue

To make

- Paint your tube and allow to dry. If you are using paper draw the face on first.
- Then wrap the paper around the tub and glue down.
- Using the paper cut out two ears. Fold a little backward long the straight edge. Secure them to the tube using the pegs.
- Pull a piece of cotton wool place it between the pegs.
- To make the beard put a small piece of cotton wool below the goat's mouth.

You can make more characters from the story. You could make the goats in three different sizes.

You could make them bigger if you use larger tubes.
