

Maths*

Make a tally chart to show what colour hair people have in your family, long or short hair or what colour eyes people have. Who is left and right handed?

Make repeating patterns using your finger prints. Hands and feet maths*



Communication and Language

Look in the mirror, what colour is your hair? Is it long or short? Curly or straight? What colour are your eyes? Talk about the differences between children.

Some children speak different languages. Ask a member of your family to teach you to say "hello" in a foreign language. Video/record your child saying it.



Understanding the World

Look at family photo albums and talk about the similarities and differences. It is important to teach them that there are lots of different types of family.

Discuss how they have changes? What could you do as a baby? And what can you do now? What can a grown up do that you would like to do?



Physical Development

Look at parts of body and name them, talk about how you look different but inside you are the same. Get some different coloured smarties or a white and brown egg. Talk about the outside being different, cut/ break them open, they are the same. Find out about what we have inside our bodies.

Talk about your favourite family meal and make it together.



Literacy

Read other stories linked to diversity, being unique and that tell the children it is okay to be different. Talk about feelings and the power of words to make people happy or hurt their feelings.
